



## DONATE BY WILL OR CODICIL

You can also remember us in your will, or if you already have one, by making a Codicil to your will.

Here's an easy way to do this, although we strongly urge you to seek legal advice, especially as it is easy to make a mistake when signing wills or codicils, and thus make them useless!

More home-made wills are now made than ever before and there are many that are now before the courts because of disputes, so it is better to play safe than be sorry.

### Specimen Gift Clause to a charity in a will:

**I Give** the sum of Five hundred pounds (£500) to Chichester Anna Chaplaincy,, registered charity number 1172058 and I declare that the receipt of its Treasurer or any Trustee shall be a good and sufficient discharge to my Executors

### Specimen Gift Clause by codicil to a will
