EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES STATEMENT

Chichester Anna Chaplaincy's vision is to provide a city wide ecumenical ministry of 'presence and compassion' for older people, their carers and relatives of all faiths or none, recognising and respecting each person where they are spiritually.

The Chaplain is required by Item 4 in the Essential Criteria of the Job Description to

The volunteers are required to

"support people of all faiths and none and no one will be excluded from the service due to their ethnicity, gender, sexuality, disability health needs, social class or nationality."

"serve and befriend without any discrimination either directly or indirectly on the grounds of sex or sexuality, colour, creed, ethnic or national origin, disability, age, marital status, trade union activity, responsibility for dependants, political or religious beliefs."
